

## Village of Clyde

**Name:** Burning in Village

**Purpose:**

The purpose of this policy is to provide direction for issuing fire permits within the Village of Clyde

**Policy Statement:**

No person shall set fire to any grass or refuse within the Village of Clyde without first obtaining a fire permit from the Fire Chief of the Village of Clyde or his designated Fire Department Manager. This includes both open fires and those contained within a burn barrel.

Fire bans will be implemented at the discretion of the Fire Chief. No fires, even if normally permitted, shall be allowed when a fire ban is in effect.

Recreational fire pits must adhere to the following regulations:

- All metal construction or brick made special for fire pits.
- Maximum of 30 inches in diameter.
- Minimum of 8 inches in height
- Pit must be at least 16 feet from any building, tree, or fence.
- Clean burning wood only (no shrubs, grass, leaves, garbage, fuel, or oil products are permitted).
- Flames should be kept to less than 3 feet in height from the ground.
- All fire pits must be approved by the Fire Chief or designated officer.
