

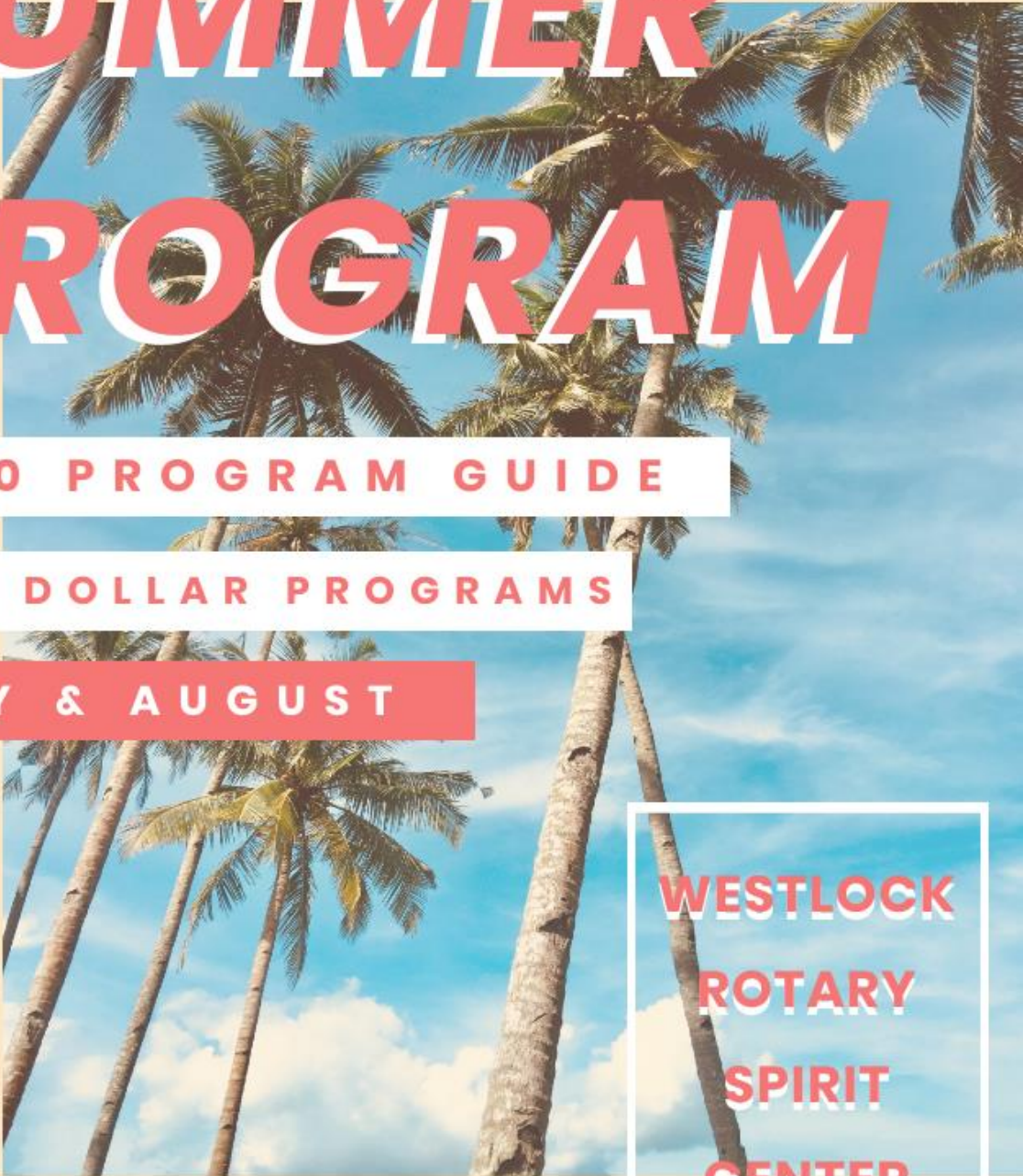

Youth Summer Program - Rules & Regulations

Registration:

- **TUESDAY, JUNE 23, 2020 at 9:00am-4pm**
- Can only be in person at **FCSS Office** or online at www.westlock.ca
- FCSS Address: #201, 10004-107 Street
- A Town of Westlock Summer Program Waiver must be completed and submitted to FCSS Office or via email to summerprograms@westlock.ca. This form must be completed for every participant, however, only needs to be once for the entire 2020 schedule of programs. **Please notify a Summer Program staff member if any of the information changes at any time.**

Program information:

- Programs run Monday through Thursday.
- Half day camps

Monday Youth days (ages 10-17)

9:00am - 12:00pm OR

1:00pm - 4:00pm

Tuesday-Wednesday-Thursday (ages 6-12)

9:00am - 12:00pm OR

1:00pm - 4:00pm

- Fee of \$5.00 per child/youth per session

Drop-Off and Pick Up Policy

To follow the Alberta Health Services guidelines with the covid-19 precaution measures our drop off and pick up policy is that:

When you arrive at the Westlock Rotary Spirit Centre families are to line up in the spaces provided for social distancing. Once you enter the facility, we ask that you sanitize you and your child's hand, then answer the pre-screening checklist.

The summer staff will check the temperature of the child before entering the program. Once all steps have been completed the child can attend the program.

Parents or guardians and children/youth must not attend the program if they are sick, even if symptoms resemble a mild cold. Symptoms to look for include fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, runny nose, nasal congestion, headache, and a general feeling of being unwell.

What you to bring:

- Sealed snacks
- Water bottle with name on it
- Sunscreen and bug spray
- Swimsuit and towel if required *Please check individual program descriptions*
- Appropriate footwear
- Dressed appropriately for forecasted weather.

The Town of Westlock and FCSS will not be responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged items. Please do not bring any valuables, electronics, or money to the Summer Program activities

Medications:

- Town of Westlock and FCSS staff will not administer or handle medication. If a medication is necessary during the activity day, please ensure your child can perform necessary steps to administer medications.
- Please alert Summer Programs staff **WHERE** the medication is, **WHAT** the medication is, **WHEN** the child will need to administer the medication.

Drop Off

- A COVID-19 pre-screening checklist form will be required to be completed by each parent before the program begins.
- Each parent or guardian must sign in the participant at the beginning of the program.
- ALL Summer Programs activities will begin at 9:00am for morning sessions and at 1:00pm for afternoon sessions.
- The Town of Westlock will not accept participants before 8:45am for morning sessions and 12:45pm for afternoon sessions, unless prior arrangements are made with Summer Program Staff members at least 24 hours in advance.
- If a participant is to bike/walk home at the end of the program session a parent or guardian must notify Summer Program Staff and specify this on the drop off form. A child will not be released to walk/bike home unless written or verbal consent is given to a Summer Program Staff member.
- Please list all individuals who have permission to pick up the participant. Summer Program staff will not release a child to individuals not listed on the sheet.
- Please notify us if your child will not be attending or will be late.
- **Drop off will be at the North Doors at the Westlock Rotary Spirit Center**

Pick Up:




- All 2020 Summer Program activities end at 12:00pm for morning sessions and 4:00pm for afternoon sessions, with the expectation that all children are picked up by 12:15pm and 4:15pm at the latest.
- Participants will only be released to individuals listed during the drop off procedure. If an unidentified person shows up to pick up the child, Summer Program Staff will call the listed parent/guardian from the Town of Westlock registration form for verbal permission before the participant is released.
- The Town of Westlock will require a printed name and signature from the individual picking up child before the participant is released.
