Everyone must complete the registration process by visiting our website www.villageofclyde.ca. Under the Utilities Tab click Utility Billing then click the blue [View/pay eBills](#) button and instructions on how to proceed will be there. You will then need to "add" each of your accounts so that you can view and/or pay online. When prompted for a PIN number this can be located on the left side of your Utility Bill. 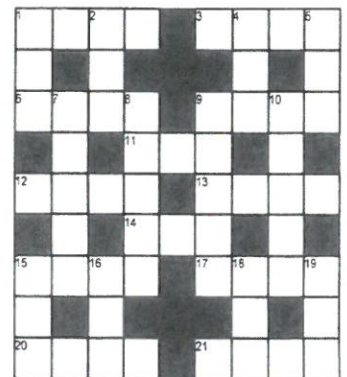
