Utility bill payments

To receive your utility bills electronically, go to www.villageofclyde.ca under the utilities tab click Utility Billing, then click the blue [view/pay eBills](#) button, then click "learn how to register" for a tutorial or "register". Complete the information required and proceed from there. You will need to choose a username (not email), password & security question, then click Continue. You should receive a message that registration was successful. You will receive a confirmation email back (from – Webmaster@JustInter.net) with a verification code & a time limit to complete the next step.

You need to click on the link & fill in Username, password & verification code. Then you will need to add your account # **exactly** as it appears on your utility bill. You will also need the **5 digit number** from your bill. From there you can pay your bill using Paypal, through online banking on your Bank's website, or at the Village office.
