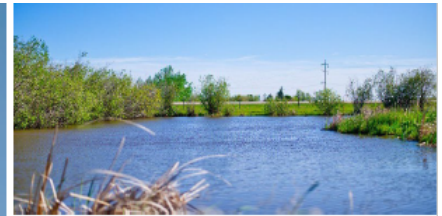
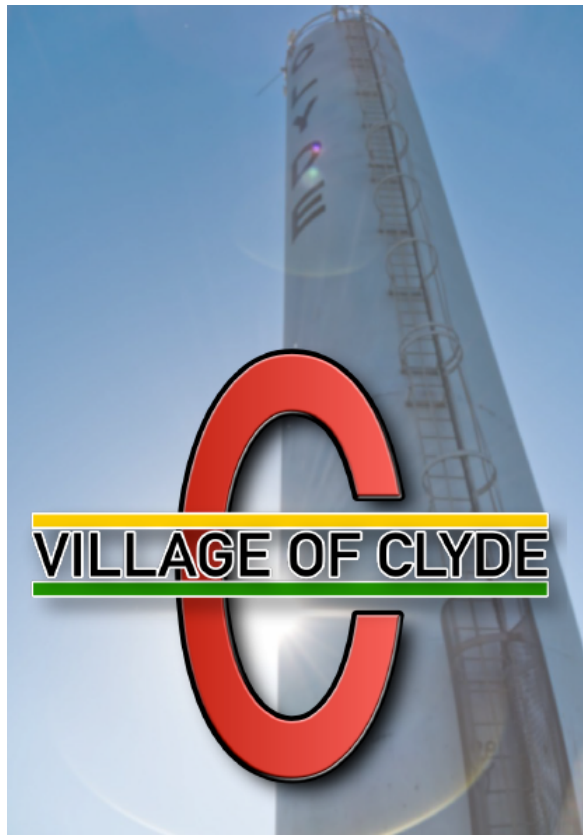

TOWN OF WESTLOCK RECYCLABLE ITEMS ACCEPTED:

Cardboard (remove liners and Styrofoam)

NO GARBAGE

- ✓ Boxboard (cereal, beer, pop boxes, etc.)
- ✓ Corrugated cardboard (boxes with a ruffled or grooved pattern inside)
- ✓ Furnace, furniture, air conditioner boxes
- ✓ Paper towel tubes
- ✓ Toilet paper tubes
- ✓ Brown paper bags
- ✓ Clean paper plates
- ✓ Egg cartons (cardboard only)



Ineligible/Unacceptable Cardboard Recycling Materials

- ✗ Wax lined cardboard
- ✗ Visibly contaminated boxes, LIKE FOOD

Newsprint

NO GARBAGE

- ✓ Newspapers/Flyers/Junk Mail
- ✓ Journals
- ✓ Magazines/Catalogues (Sear's, Canadian Tire, Chatelaine, etc.)
- ✓ Brown envelopes (with or without plastic windows)
- ✓ Paperback books/Hard cover books
- ✓ Telephone books
- ✓ File folders/Duo tangs
- ✓ Colored paper
- ✓ Stickers
- ✓ Construction paper
- ✓ Tan packing paper
- ✓ Calendars/Posters
- ✓ Gift wrap paper
- ✓ Pictures



Ineligible/Unacceptable Newsprint Materials

- ✗ Dirty Napkins
- ✗ Dirty Paper towels
- ✗ Carbon paper
- ✗ Sanitary products
- ✗ Kleenex tissue
- ✗ Fabric softener sheets
- ✗ Shop/hand towels

White Office Paper In separate bag if possible

NO GARBAGE

- ✓ Office paper
- ✓ Writing/lined paper
- ✓ Notebook paper
- ✓ Legal paper
- ✓ Fax paper
- ✓ White packing paper
- ✓ White Envelopes (with or without plastic windows)
- ✓ White Shredded paper (**bagged please!**)



Ineligible/Unacceptable White Office Paper Materials

- ✗ Contaminated papers
- ✗ Wax paper
- ✗ Colored paper/Carbon paper

ABSOLUTELY NO!!!!

- ✗ Construction Materials like sawdust, wood, floor dry, scrap metal, shingles, insulation, drywall
- ✗ Pet litter
- ✗ Diapers
- ✗ Compost
- ✗ Glass
- ✗ Wet Waste

Why the restrictions:

1. We hand sort the recycle materials for better management
2. Some materials, like compost, contaminates the other recycle materials and makes them non-recyclable
3. Staff safety and health
4. Products may not be recyclable

"I Want To Recycle, But What Can I Actually Recycle?"

The Westlock Regional Waste Management Commission has a specific list of what can and cannot be recycled at their facility. The pictures below show the list of do's and don'ts. In short, they do take: Cardboard (please bag separately), paper, tin, and plastics 1-7 (Not sure which plastic it is? Look on the bottom of the plastic container in question, and there should be a number inside the recycle symbol. Is it between 1-7? You're good to go!) They DO NOT accept: glass, film, dirty cardboard (stained with food...etc) . For more info, see the charts:



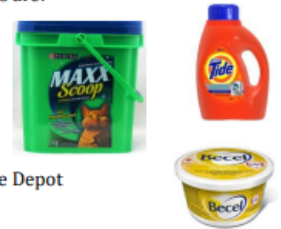
1- #7 Plastics (Solid Plastics)

NO GARBAGE



All Plastic containers with a #1 to #7 on the bottom, rinsed please
Some examples of these food and non food solid plastics are:

- ✓ Shampoo, conditioner bottles
- ✓ Margarine tubs
- ✓ Laundry soap and fabric softener containers
- ✓ Liquid soap containers
- ✓ Salad dressing containers
- ✓ Kitty litter containers, etc
- ✓ Vinegar jugs
- ✓ Plastic milk jugs marked are refundable at the Bottle Depot



Ineligible/Unacceptable #1-#7 Plastic Materials

- ✗ Pesticide containers – there is a recycling cell at the Sanitary Landfill for those
- ✗ Some plastic toys (look for the symbols)
- ✗ Some types of clothes hangers (look for the symbols)
- ✗ Styrofoam
- ✗ Garden hoses
- ✗ PVC tubing
- ✗ Toilet seats
- ✗ House siding
- ✗ Window blinds

Tin/Aluminums

NO GARBAGE

- ✓ All food/non food tin or aluminum cans
- ✓ Tin foil
- ✓ Metal pie plates/trays
- ✓ Empty non-hazardous aerosol cans
- ✓ Lightly rinsed



Ineligible/Unacceptable Tin/Aluminum

- ✗ Contaminated/Dirty cans
- ✗ Frying pans
- ✗ Pieces of metal (we have a metal pile for this)
- ✗ Hyper dermic Needles (sharps)
- ✗ Please throw away sharp lids
