

# **Our Apologies**

We understand the frustration of residents and visitors when they were surprised to see the new locked gate at the public works yard blocking access to the Sani-Dump station during the August long weekend.

Regrettably, there was an oversight in communication, and the information about the operational hour update had not been re-posted since spring 2023.

As a result of theft from the public works yard, increasing costs due to ongoing misuse of the compost pile and liability concerns of both residents and non-residents having access of the public works yard, 24 hours a day - 7 days a week, discussion relating to the compost pile and Sani-Dump were brought to Council for review in October 2022.

While, operating hours had been included in the May Newsletter, the new gate installation, which was completed on August 3rd, enforces the accessible hours for both facilities.

The Westlock Regional Waste Management Facility is open Tuesday-Friday from 10:00am to 5:45pm and Saturday from 9:00am to 4:45pm if you need to dump your compost after hours.

Compost site will be reviewed by council in October 2023, and Administration is anticipating that construction of the new Sani-Dump location will be underway later this fall.
