ESTABLISH THE POSITION OF DESIGNATED OFFICER – Municipal Assessor

**A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF CLYDE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA,
TO ESTABLISH THE POSITION OF DESIGNATED OFFICER.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of section 210 of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, Chapter M-26, the Council may pass a bylaw to establish one or more positions to carry out the powers, duties and functions of a designated officer.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Clyde, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, does hereby enact as follows:

1. That the position of Assessor be established to carry out the duties and responsibilities of an Assessor as Designated Officer in the Municipal Government Act.
2. That this bylaw replaces Bylaw 2014-02.
3. That this bylaw shall take effect on the date of the third and final reading:
