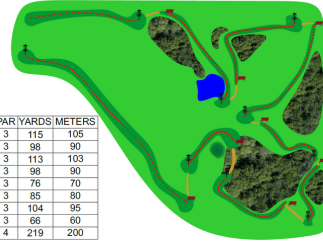

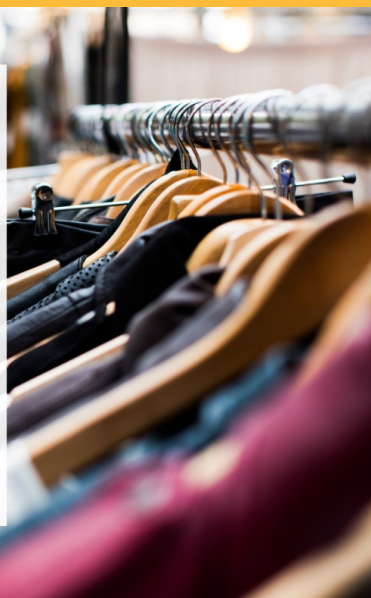
The last date before a four (4%) percent penalty will be levied is June 30, 2023 and the last date before an eight (8%) percent penalty will be levied is July 31, 2023.

# VILLAGE WIDE CLEAN UP COMING YOUR WAY!



## Village Wide Clean Up June 24, 2023

Please place your unwanted items on your **front curb** for rummaging from **June 19** until **pick up on June 24, 2023.**

### **ALL ACCEPTABLE ITEMS MUST BE OUT ON THE FRONT CURB NO LATER THAN 7 A.M. OR IT WILL NOT GET PICKED UP!**

(Sorry, we cannot go down back alleys or back yards to collect items)

**The spring cleanup is to help remove heavy unwanted household items.**

There is no charge for this except for any appliances with Freon.

**A \$20.00 disposal fee is due in advance at the office for all fridges & freezers to be removed.**

**All grass clipping, branches & compost materials are not accepted AND WILL NOT BE COLLECTED.**

**The following items are also not accepted**

- All chemical and/or agriculture chemical containers and/or liquids
- Sewage/septic tanks
- Batteries
- Tar
- Renovation or landscaping materials
- Oil or oil filters
- Hazardous/toxic/radioactive waste
- Drums asbestos
- Tire and/or rims
- Vehicle hulks
- Antifreeze
- Dead animals or animal waste

**PLEASE NOTE: We will not be picking up garbage bags at all, regular household waste remains a garbage cart service!**

#### Acceptable Electronics:

- Televisions
- Laptops
- CPUs and Servers
- Tablets
- Computers
- Computer Monitors
- Printers
- Copiers
- Scanners
- Fax Machines
- Keyboards
- Computer Mice

#### Acceptable Paint Products:

- Containers under 23 liters
- Interior/Exterior Varnishes, Stains & Shellac
- Spray Paint Cans
- Enamels
- Latex Paint
- Marine Paint
- Concrete Sealers
- Stone Effect Coating

**\*\*Material that cannot be identified as acceptable products will not be picked up\*\***

**\*\*Items not sorted into Separate Piles - Electronic and Paint – will not be picked up\*\***
