RATE CHANGES FOR UTILITIES

Rate changes for utilities are coming February 1, 2023, due to an increase in service delivery costs. This is to ensure cost recovery for the village. Pursuant to Village of Clyde Rates Fees and Changes Bylaw No. #2012-12-04.

New Rates (as per bylaw): Infrastructure Fee - \$21.00/month (Inside Village) or \$31.38/month (Outside Village) Water Fee - \$3.95 m/3 (Inside Village) or \$4.55 m/3 (Outside Village) Garbage Fee - \$19.00/Cart per month Recycling Fee - \$5.00/Month Tippage Fee - First 250 kg/year per residence included. \$0.25/kg after 250kg allotment. Waste Management Reserve Fee - \$2.74/month
