Westlock Area Crime Coalition (WACC)

The Westlock Area Crime Coalition (WACC) is part of the Westlock Regional Notification System. WACC is a tool to help RCMP notify residents of relevant information such as crimes in progress and road closures. S/Sgt. Al Baird states that residents can assist RCMP safely, for example, by looking out their windows or spotting vehicles and calling the RCMP with the location.

Baird stresses that the WACC system only becomes effective for reducing crime in the area as more residents sign up. The system is an initiative between the Town of Westlock, Westlock County, the Village of Clyde, Citizens On Patrol and the RCMP.

Emails are sent out to residents that sign up. Baird stresses that residents will not be inundated with emails. The broadcasts will only be important real time information for residents. Continued on page 4.
