## Property Taxes, **Still Owing?**

For those with a balance remaining on 2022 Land Taxes, as of August 1, 2022 there will be an additional 8% penalty added. To avoid this penalty, make sure your Taxes are paid in full. You can pay through your bank (online or via phone), or at our Village of Clyde Office (cheque, cash or debit).



## Fire Pit **Permits**

Summer is here! Risks associated with dry weather has increased! Let's all do our part in avoiding wildfires. We at the Village of Clyde would like to send a friendly reminder that fire pit permits are required for backyard fire pits.

Under the Fire Protection By Law, Section 5; the Village of Clyde requires residents to obtain a fire pit permit to enable backyard fire pits. The Fire Pit Permit applications can be found on the Village of Clyde website at [www.villageofclyde.ca/permit-license-bylaw](http://www.villageofclyde.ca/permit-license-bylaw) or we can supply one for you at the Village of Clyde Office. Fire Pit Permits are only \$20.00 for the lifetime of the fire pit.

BYLAW 2022-06-02

#### BEING A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH ALTERNATE METHODS OF ADVERTISING STATUTORY NOTICES OF THE VILLAGE OF CLYDE

Pursuant to Sections 7, 606 and 606.1 of the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, (MGA) as amended, the Council of the Village of Clyde hereby gives notice of its intention to adopt Bylaw 2022-06-02

The purpose of Bylaw 2022-06-02 is to:

- This Bylaw will enable the Village of Clyde to provide notice of a bylaw, resolution, meeting, Public Hearing, election or any item required under Section 606 of the MGA within the timelines prescribed under Section 606 by a minimum of any two (2) of the following methods;
  - by posting electronically on the Village's website;
  - by posting electronically on any official Village Social Media Platform;
  - by advertising in a Newspaper or Newsletter circulated in the area, which includes the Clyde Connection;
  - by posting in the Village's opt-in communications;
  - by mailing or delivering notice pursuant to Section 602(2)(b) of the MGA, or
  - by placing on the Community Bulletin Boards located outside of the Post Office located at 4828-50 Street in Clyde, Alberta.

THEREFORE TAKE NOTICE THAT pursuant to Sections 7, 606 and 606.1 of the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, as amended, a public hearing to consider the proposed Bylaw will be held:

Date: Monday, September 12, 2022

Time: 6:00 p.m.

Place: Village of Clyde Council Chambers located at 4812 – 50 Street, in Clyde, Alberta.

FURTHER, TAKE NOTICE THAT anyone wishing to make a verbal or written representation may do so at the hearing, or by providing the representation to the Village's Chief Administrative Officer before 12:00 p.m. on Friday, September 09, 2022.

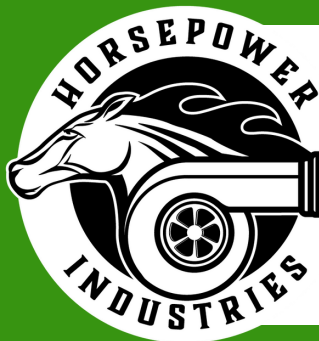
