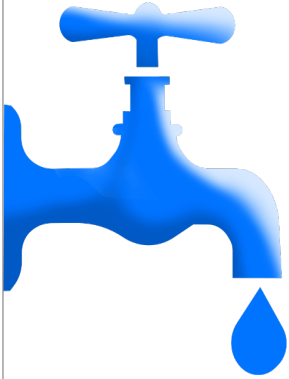

Water Rates



The Village of Clyde's current water rate is set to be \$3.75 per cubic meter in accordance to Bylaw 2021-10-01-Rates and Fees Bylaw and there will be an increase of \$0.10 per cubic meter of water consumption. This will become effective starting February 1, 2022, which results in a new water rate of \$3.85 in the Village and \$4.45 for consumers outside the Village of Clyde corporate limits.
