POLICY TITLE: Community Sponsorship Granting Policy

POLICY NUMBER: 2023-10-01

POLICY PURPOSE:

The Village of Clyde has established a Community Sponsorship Grant Program to provide financial assistance towards projects or events which are community driven to enhance and enrich the quality of life in the Village of Clyde. Through the program, the Village of Clyde wishes to encourage initiatives from locally based, registered, non-profit and community organizations which will impact a broad cross-section of the community, encouraging new opportunities for social and cultural events and activities. The intent is to attract more community driven initiatives which support Councils vision to become a hub of Cultural Activity through collaborative opportunities.

The Village of Clyde has established a Community Sponsorship Grant Policy which provides community sponsorship grants to not for profit community groups or organizations within the Village of Clyde for community development and cultural purposes. Projects, events, activities, and recreational accomplishments focused on attaining positive outcomes for the community may be funded through this program.

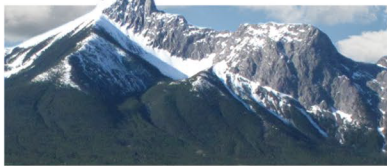

Alberta RCMP Eastern Alberta District Detachment to Implement Safe Exchange Zones

Eastern Alberta – Early in 2024 22 of the 27 detachments of Alberta RCMP's Eastern Alberta District will be implementing a safe exchange zone program.

With the advent of new technologies, Alberta residents actively connect with one and other to conduct sales and purchases. Although many of these transactions occur safely without issue, there are safety risks associated with meeting anyone online. Additionally, there are many other interactions where the public may have concerns about their safety such as child custody, and document exchanges.

In an effort to improve safety in the communities we serve, Eastern Alberta District detachments with the ability to accommodate these zones are implementing designated safe exchange zones. These zones will be clearly marked outside Eastern Alberta District Detachments as either parking stalls or a designated area. Residents need not contact the detachment to use the site. Simply advise the person that you are meeting that you would like to meet at the safe exchange zone outside the designated detachment.

“These safe exchange zones will provide a safer place for citizens to safely meet while making sales, purchases and exchanges including custody and visitation arrangements,” says Staff Sgt. Jeff Sehn of the Westlock RCMP Detachment.

The safe exchange zone is not specifically monitored by the detachment or surveillance cameras, however, detachment officers are available to assist should there be a call for assistance. Any criminal activity is subject to enforcement action.

WASTE DISPOSAL REMINDER

1. Cart lids must be closed and be facing towards the street (Otherwise it can break the wheels).
2. No loose garbage as it can fly away and make a mess along the streets in the village.
3. The carts must be placed on the street and not on the sidewalk or lawn.
4. There must be a minimum of 3 feet of space between the cart and its surroundings (including any recycling bags).
