# Village of Clyde Snow Clearing & Maintenance

## WHEN CAN YOU EXPECT SNOW REMOVAL TO START?

Snow removal will begin based on priorities described in our "Snow and Ice Control Policy". Please view the policy on our website:

### Snowfall Conditions:

Accumulations and drifting between 0-5 cm causing unsafe driving conditions.

### Action:

Sanding and hazardous drift clearing will be completed on a priority area basis.

### Time Completion Target:

10 hours

### Snowfall Conditions:

Accumulations and drifting between 5-10 cm.

### Action:

Priority 1 roads will be plowed followed by Priority 2.

### Time Completion Target:

30 hours

### Snowfall Conditions:

Accumulations and drifting between 10-15cm.

### Action:

Priority 1 roads will be plowed followed by priority 2.

### Time Completion Target:

40 Hours

### Snowfall Conditions:

Accumulations and drifting greater than 15cm.

### Action:

Plowing will begin with priority 1 roads and finish with priority 2 roads.

### Time Completion Target:

48 Hours

### Snowfall Conditions:

Freezing rain.

### Action:

Sanding of intersections will be completed

### Time Completion Target:

4 - 6 hours



Curb ramps must be removed by Nov 1. The Village will not be liable for missing or damaged ramps.



Residents are responsible for clearing all snow and ice from walkways withing 48 hours of snow & drifting.



Avoid fines by not shoveling your snow onto the road, drainage ditch, or property not belonging to you.



Please keep Fire Hydrants on or near your property clear of accumulated snow.



Please contact the Village office to sign up to be a "Snow Angel" for those in need, or join the recipient list.



Please do not park on street during snow clearing.

Snow Clearing signs will be placed at least 24 hours prior to clearing whenever possible.


