

The Village of Clyde is following the direction of Alberta Health Services (AHS), Government of Alberta and Health Canada.

WHAT DOES COVID-19 MEAN TO US:

- Work continues as before, office will be open to the public on June 1, 2020 with limited hours for now. 9:30—11:30 a.m. and 1:30—3:30 p.m.
- All staff continue to work separately to comply with physical distancing recommendations set out by the province.
- Village staff continue to meet daily using a virtual meeting to review issues, duties, updates and serve the needs of the community.
- Administration are in contact with Disaster Management at least weekly and provide substantial changes to the Council.
- Council and Administration are constantly monitoring Alberta Health updates to bring you the most current information.
- Meetings with our neighboring municipalities' CAO's — Town of Westlock and Westlock County continue weekly to ensure consistency.

COVID-19

The Playground will remain closed at this time. Council will consider an opening date at their next meeting on Monday, June 8, 2020.

The Campground remains closed except for the "Spectre Paving Crew" conducting paving in the community.

The Ball Diamonds will be closed until further notice pending instruction from the province.

At this time, backyard fire pits are allowed in the Village of Clyde, assuming they meet the guidelines. *Note as well that going forward there is a \$20 one time charge for the Inspection and Approval of your Fire Pit.

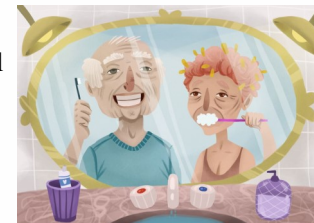
